CANCER and THE YEAR AHEAD

Happy Birthday, Cancer! You are the first Water Sun Sign in the Zodiac; your sign rules the 4th House of home and family, people who live with you, foundations, base of operations, household matters including decorating, design, renovation and real estate; mother and sometimes father, your sixth sense, gardening, landscaping or

This year the Sun enters your sign on June 20 at 6:34 PM EDT and leaves on July 22 at 5:30 AM EDT.

Enjoy the remaining months of **Jupiter** in Virgo until it **moves to Libra on September 9** and occupies your solar 4th House of home and family where you encounter plenty of action as you solve issues related to household members, tackle home projects, spend money on new furniture or provide advice and counsel to loved ones. **Saturn in Sagittarius is retrograde during this month in your solar 6th house of work, health, daily environments, colleagues, pets and nutrition. Those of you born July 2-5 feel the impact most so get ready to change routines.** Since Saturn stays in a sign for 2-1/2 years, you could feel like work is never done, juggling several assignments, taking on diverse tasks or working two jobs. This transit especially affects those of you born June 28-July 6 and taps into the spiritual side of your life. Give your energy to situations that bring you joy. **Pluto in Capricorn connects with Cancers born July 5-10 in your solar 7th House of business, personal and romantic partners; medical practitioners and advisors, roommates, collaborators, the public, consultants and legal practitioners.** Some of you could be dealing with endings - of relationships, projects and ventures that have run their course. Some of you could move closer to an existing relationship or take serious steps to make it permanent. Since Pluto relates to regeneration, you can expect your heart and mind to heal once you understand the reason for the break with close ties. An intense aspect like this points up the need to face the music and deal with the truth. It may be a slow-moving planet but you won't be able to leave unfinished business when it hits you sun, so get ready. If you are a Cancer born with some planets in the other Cardinal signs, Capricorn, Libra or Aries, you will experience the impact of Pluto, the great transformer. With **Pluto in Capricorn** in your 7th House you encounter the challenge to examine your relationship with yourself and what you have been hiding in the shadows. This year's 5 eclipses affect you as follows: The first **eclipse that influenced your birthday year was the March 8 New Moon eclipse in Pisces occurring in your solar 9th house of travel, the higher mind, in-laws, spirituality and publishing.** Those of you who travel for your job are going to be busy juggling tight time schedules while those of you who are feeling the wanderlust could be booking a trip far from home. For some of you that means a dream trip. Others have plans to further your education in institutes of higher learning; others strengthen resumes while some Cancers embrace a spiritual goal. A sabbatical or professional training opportunity makes you more competitive and qualified. The **March 23 Full Moon lunar eclipse in Libra fell in your solar 4th House** and emphasizes your base of operation or home, family, foundation, parents, home remodeling and décor, garden and landscaping, and real estate transactions. THE PLANETS' ACTIVITY JUNE 20-July 22, 2016

The Summer Solstice occurs today at 6:34 PM EDT, the longest day of the year; the Full Moon (2nd one in Sagittarius in a month occurs 10 hours earlier and that doesn't happen often - called the Blue Moon). Four retrograde planets have been traveling the heavens - Mars at 23° Scorpio, Saturn at 11° Sagittarius, Neptune at 12° Pisces and Pluto at 16° Capricorn. Neptune was the first to turn direct on June 13th and is now affecting Pisces born March 1-3, Geminis born June 1-3, Virgos born September 3-5 and Sagittarius born December 3-5. Mutable planets have been caught up in a Grand Cross meaning that the pairs are represented by opposite signs crossing one another and creating challenging conditions. The signs most affected are Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius and Pisces (Mercury, Jupiter, Saturn and Neptune are the current players). You will be feeling their effects if you are a member of these signs or have

planets in these signs. **Saturn in Sagittarius opposing Mercury in Gemini and squaring Neptune could mean encounters with scammers, those who distort the truth, erroneous diagnoses or conditions that could play havoc with reality.** If money is involved - Jupiter in Virgo - watch out if making a transaction that you don't get trapped into paying for something that is not going to hold value. **Neptune went retrograde in Pisces on June 12 and goes direct on November 18; those born February 28-March 2 feel it the strongest this month; Pluto in Capricorn is retrograde throughout the Cancer cycle and so is Chiron in Pisces as of June 25.** If you are born March 11-13 Chiron most affects you during this time. **Mercury wraps up the Gemini cycle** with its emphasis on quality communication and coordinated events on June 29 and rapidly moves through the realm of family-loving, Cancer through July 13 before moving to Leo. **Venus is in Cancer through July 13th in harmonious aspect to Jupiter** giving you the opportunity to enjoy holidays, vacations, socializing and flirting. After we pass the middle of the month Mercury and Mars oppose Pluto and arguments over politics, financial decisions and opposing points of view make headlines. **Uranus in Aries** is still within striking distance of transiting Pluto in Capricorn and is the stronger of the two now since Pluto is retrograde. The activity of those of you born April 11-14 gets the most attention, especially if you are making plans behind the scenes. With Mars in Scorpio in the mix human rights are in the limelight and more abuse cases surface. **Chiron in Pisces is retrograde and gives you time to ponder solutions to long held dilemmas if you are a Pisces born March 14-16.** Ignoring signs creates more angst so take the time to heal old wounds.

PEOPLE, PLACES, EVENTS, AND TOPICS IN THE NEWS

The Gemini newsletter generated several comments and questions on current events, government security, personalities in the news, and how the planets influence events that occur. Since the devastating Orlando shootings, the mail has overwhelmingly turned to questions asking for an explanation of this horrible tragedy. Orlando has been in the news for three unHINGING events since June 10: the murder of singer Christina Grimmie by an obsessive fan who killed her while she was signing autographs after a concert (she was only 22 years old); 49 patrons of a gay nightclub were assassinated and 53 others wounded by a deranged man with an assault rifle (almost all were very young individuals as was the killer); and a 2-year-old toddler visiting Walt Disney World was dragged into a lagoon by an alligator and was found dead 17 hours later. Note the emphasis on youth in the findings for Orlando.

Orlando, Florida: European settlers discovered Orlando in 1536 when it was populated by the Seminole Tribe. Various dates show up in the history from 1856-1875 declaring Orlando the seat of government in Orange County and I am using the date it was incorporated as a town, July 31, 1975 to interpret the city's chart - it was actually incorporated as a city in 1885. Astrology reference books are also at odds with the date. The 1875 date makes sense since this city is known for its emphasis on

entertainment and houses the most frequented vacation destination in the world, Walt Disney World. What a chart! Leo dominates: Vesta, the Sun, Pallas, Juno, Uranus and Ceres in Leo (fun, games, amusements, children, free spirits, vacations); Mercury, Venus and the Moon in Cancer (family, children, love, luxury, parents, nurturing); Jupiter and Part of Fortune in Libra in harmonious aspect to the Leo placements; Saturn in Aquarius square Pluto in Taurus square Ceres in Leo forming a hard aspect that when triggered creates chaos; Mars in Sagittarius (getting a hit now from transiting Saturn in that sign) and Neptune in Taurus in hard aspect to Vesta and the Sun. Transiting retrograde Mars in Scorpio was at 23 degrees during this time and a number of Orlando's progressed planets also hit the **23rd degree**: Mercury, the Ascendant and the Part of Fortune while the Mars passage harshly triggered the energy of natal Ceres in Leo at 23, Saturn in Aquarius at 23 degrees, Pluto in Taurus at 23 - opposing Mars -- violence of the worst kind; transiting Uranus (chaos, unexpected events) at 23 degrees Aries and transiting Venus in Gemini hit 23 degrees of the sign on June 12th fueling the devastating carnage that was unfolding. Mars is going direct at this degree of Scorpio on June 29 and that trigger degree could also put Orlando back in the news again. And the icing on the cake? The murderer, whose name I will not list, is a Scorpio born November 16 with his Sun at 23 Scorpio and Mars in hard aspect at 23° Aquarius. His birth chart synched exactly with the planets in movement and Orlando's chart on that fateful day that saw the bloodiest terrorist attack by a shooter in American history.

Sandra Lee: This delightful cooking and talk show host is a Cancer born July 3, in Santa Monica, CA. Her life is consistent with that of a true Cancerian. She survived a difficult childhood after her parents' divorce when she was 2 and lived with her nurturing grandmother, Lorraine, who influenced her interest in cooking. Sandra, an Emmy-nominated host, is best known for her Food Network shows *Semi-Homemade* and *Sandra's Money Saving Meals* which ran for many seasons. She also authored 25 cookbooks filled with luscious meals and entertainment tips as well as her 2007 memoir "*Made From Scratch*". Her chart is very entrepreneurial with a signature Sun and Jupiter conjunction in Cancer - perfect combination for her successes in the food, decorating and home product businesses that she successfully launched. In 2015 she was diagnosed with breast cancer and underwent a double mastectomy. Sandra now lives with long-time partner, NY Governor Andrew Cuomo whom she has dated since 2005. Let's wish Sandra a Happy 50th birthday and a long and healthy life.

READERS' CORNER

Thank you for the many questions, feedback and comments you sent during the past month. Here are a few reader concerns that I hope you find helpful.

Q. My friend has been dating a man for 15 months who seems too good for words. He is kind, thoughtful, caring, sends her flowers each month to mark the day they met, buys her gifts for special occasions as well as just for the heck of it, takes her out for meals, entertainment and adventure, and listens to her problems without judgement when she shares them. They seem to love being together all the time. She is a Pisces and he is a Cancer. What makes them such a compatible match? I would like to know what planets and aspects to look for to find the perfect partner. Our mutual friends agree they belong together.

A. Well, dear reader, I am happy to provide you with some insight into what makes this happy couple tick. If you look at these connections, you'll get a feel for what fulfills

relationships. Let's begin with their Suns which are in harmonious aspect to one another. The man's Mercury and Venus in Leo fall on her natal Moon in Leo, a very good tie for communication, love, affection and compatibility. She's on his mind a lot and vice versa. Plus, he has Uranus in Sagittarius in trine (favorable) aspect to these Leo planets that add spontaneity and fun to the mix. His generosity and tendency to shower her with gifts come from Jupiter (money, wealth, expansion) in his chart that falls on her Pisces Sun and gives them the opportunity to build their friendship, enjoy diverse ventures and easily afford the expenses associated with their preferences. Neptune in Capricorn (translates like Venus elevated) in his chart makes a harmonious aspect to her Venus in Pisces (love is at work). Mars in Capricorn in his chart forms a perfect trine to her Mars in Taurus - passion blossoms here; they are on the same wavelength. Last but not least, her ascendant is Leo with all his Leo connections and her Moon meeting in her first house, while his Ascendant is Aquarius - which becomes her 7th House of partners - and her natal Mercury in in Aquarius falls right on the cusp of his Ascendant. Their theme song could be "Always on My Mind," and I'm betting you'll be getting an invitation to their wedding before long.

Q. I am a female Cancer with a Sagittarius Moon. When I read the write-ups online and in books about Cancer, I don't seem to fit the description in most circumstances. For example, I don't like to cook, I hate housework, I live by myself, don't care to host others in my home and I'm not shy. Sometimes the material in your yearly overview for Cancer fits but not always. Please explain what is driving my chart. I have been reading these newsletters for six years. What is the best way to integrate the information? Thank you for your help.

A. Every individual has a chart that is uniquely their own and is hard to repeat by others. If all Cancers, or any signs were exactly alike it would make the world a very boring place to hang out. A look at your chart shows that you have a Sagittarius Ascendant with the Moon and Neptune in Sagittarius in your 1st house and Uranus in Sagittarius in the 12th House of seclusion but very close to your Ascendant. These placements show that Sagittarius is a very strong influence in your chart and you relate more to that sign than you do Cancer. You would rather be on the move, traveling or finding outlets to rid you of your restless energy. You have the very strong Cancer trait of developing self-sufficiency. While not shy, you value your privacy, another Cancer trait and living alone allows you to cocoon or retreat, something that all Cancers do from time to time. You would benefit from reading the newsletter on Sagittarius and reading that daily horoscope as well because that is the sign on your first house and Jupiter, Sagittarius' ruling planet drives your chart pattern. Natal Jupiter in Capricorn opposite your Sun in Cancer in the 8th House occupies your 2nd House of income indicating that you are intensely concentrating on your career and resources. If you are considering a job change this is the year to do it. Your patience has been tested related to career and you're ready to break out of the rut. I don't feel that you always lived alone and may have broken ties with a spouse or significant other over the past year. The main problem could have related to your need for personal space and incompatible biorhythms/chemistry with a partner. Right now you have Saturn in Sagittarius traveling through your 1st house with the eclipses in Pisces and Virgo moving through your 4th and 10th Houses, factors that show disruption of routine. Perhaps you not only broke up/divorced but also moved since early 2015. You are capable of absorbing an abundance of material with your excellent memory (a Cancer trait) and appear to have a budding legal mind. Love who you are and enjoy your personal gifts so that you can move in new directions when unfolding dynamics play out this year.
