## PLANETS' POSITIONS FEBRUARY 19 - MARCH 20

The eclipses of February continue to dominate the astrological and global vibrations in the first half of 2017 and will continue the momentum throughout the year when the next set takes place in August in Aquarius and Leo. On February 26<sup>th</sup>, the first Solar Eclipse of the year occurs at 8° 12' and most affects Pisces born February 24-27; Virgos born August 30-September 1; Geminis born May 28-30 and Sagittarius born

November 29-December 2. The other signs most affected by this year's eclipses are Leo, Aquarius, Taurus and Scorpio. **Venus travels through Aries in this cycle**, often a sign that weather could be excessively dry resulting in fires. Socially, it can be a very passionate time for **Aries since Mars is also in your sign** and ignites the sparks in romantic relationships. Attraction is the word; so is temperament and sassy dialog. Venus goes retrograde at 13 Aries on March 5 and eventually goes back to Pisces before completing its Aries cycle in early June. **Mercury the planet of communication wraps up a stint in Aquarius until February 25; quickly travels through Pisces and moves to Aries on March 13.** Expect stimulating conversations, lots of political debate in your inner circles as well as work place groups and a bit of confusion over plans and perspectives. Daytime TV is going to take a hit with programming due to unscheduled conferences to sort out the daily grind in a new administration. **Retrograde Jupiter in Libra** stays in the reverse pattern until June 10 and mostly affects the Libras born from the 22<sup>nd</sup> back to the 20<sup>th</sup> degree of your sign; once it goes direct it will visit your Libra Sun again and will bring you the changes you are expecting. Continue working on any plans or projects that are already in motion. Also affected are mutable signs with planets at the 22<sup>nd</sup> - 20<sup>th</sup> degrees of your sign (Gemini, Sagittarius, and Pisces). New opportunities are in the works and now you have time to refine details. **Saturn in Sagittarius most affects those born December 16-20** and reminds you to examine contracts and binding documents, insist on home inspections if buying property, schedule medical checkups, and take some time off to regroup if you have been feeling tired. Many of you are relieved that Sagittarius will leave your sign after mid-December. Other signs that have strong Saturn aspects with planets at the 25<sup>th</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> degrees are: Gemini, Virgo and Pisces. Make plans to examine current goals and stay on solid ground. **Uranus the planet of the unexpected has been fully engaged in the lives of Aries born April 10-13 and gives a new definition to the meaning of Aries' high energy.** You'll be aware of Uranus's presence if you are born with planets at 21-23 degrees of Aries, Cancer, Libra and Capricorn. High drama has been present for these signs, especially Aries for several years enhancing motivation, power and initiative, and challenging you along the way. A Grand Cross is building among the 4 cardinal signs with Uranus in Aries in hard aspect to Pluto in Capricorn, Jupiter in Libra and Vesta in Cancer. You will feel it if you have planets at approximately 20-23 degrees of these signs. ## PEOPLE, PLACES AND TOPICS IN THE NEWS

I received numerous questions from readers and their friends regarding the election and key players in the Trump administration. He featured grilled cheese and tomato soup as one of the best dishes he ever ate while on a road trip in California where he now resides. **President Trump's White House:** What a world we are in right now! The eclipse in Leo I cited in last month's newsletter is directly stimulating the activity in Washington and the President's chart. I would prefer to write about the daily slings and arrows that are disrupting the lives of ordinary citizens, government workers, the press, pundits, immigrants, the Congress, medical profession and those who are in search of the truth as well as a press conference that makes sense. Mixed messages dominate the media and confusion and untruths reign - as you have probably noticed, the President doesn't like the 4<sup>th</sup> Estate. Maureen Dowd's February 14 column in The Tampa Bay Times says it has taken Donald Trump only 8 days to achieve majority disapproval in the Gallop Polls (N.Y. Times, 2017) yet he has indeed "made America Great Again by stimulating the passions of feminism, liberalism, student activism, newspapers, cable news, protesters, bartenders, shrinks, Twitter, the ACLU and Frederick Douglass." Trump has breathed new life into SNL through performances by Alec Baldwin, Kate McKinnon and Melissa McCarthy; George Orwell's "1984" is being reprinted to keep up with the demand; and Stephen Colbert's Late Show is amassing record ratings. Other high focus topics have been Russia, Nordstrom, coaches taking political stands, the division of church and state and *The Federalist Papers*. Countries around the world are in a state of disbelief over the erratic treatment of policy and protocol.

Instead of focusing on what has happened in the last 24-hours that has been changing momentarily, I am dedicating this space to answer many of your queries about the birthdays of individuals on the President's team. **Chief Strategist Steve Bannon**, reported initiator of the 7-country Muslim travel ban and advocate of tearing up the U.N.-brokered nuclear deal with Iran, is a Sagittarius born November 27 in Norfolk, VA. His chart has many close connections to Trump's and his Jupiter (press, publicity, foreign interests) falls right on Trump's natal Uranus, North Node and Sun in Gemini. Communication shakeups! You're fired! Both men also have strong connections to Putin's chart. Stay tuned. For now, **Capricorn Kellyanne Conway January 20, 1967, Camden, NJ** is Counselor to President Trump in an increasingly difficult role that has put her in hot water with news media for defending "alternative facts" touted by the new administration and for hawking Ivanka Trump's clothing line at Nordstrom's, a conflict of interest role for government employees. Kellyanne also talks a lot about "fake news." Her chart does show that she has a strong inclination to protect The President and cover his Achille's heel. White House Press Secretary **Sean Spicer, a Libra born September 23, 1971 in Barrington, RI**, has been in the embarrassing position of having to report information that has no substance and is refuted shortly after he makes his announcements. Most analysts feel he is being forced to report these "facts" even though he knows they are not true. It has been embarrassing to watch him sputter during questioning as witnesses dispute his information. Last weekend's political shows featured **Steven Miller, the latest White House spokesperson**, who made the rounds showing an ability to lie at a rapid pace in a grating monotone. Bluntly, he was not a hit on any of the Sunday broadcasts. Miller is a **Virgo born August 23, 1985 in Santa Monica, CA**. Per voice analyst, John West, Miller displayed the type of smug delivery that makes everyone wish he would just stop talking. Wonder who will show up next week? What is your take?

## READERS CORNER

Thank you for your comments on last month's questions regarding romance and relationships. A reader submitted this question; maybe it reflects your own chart.

**Q.** Please explain what it means to have several planets in the First House. I don't seem to have any down time in my life no matter how much I plan. In fact, I often feel like I'm on a runaway train. I was born on March 4. Will I always have this pattern or will I get better organized and experience less intensity?

**A.** You are a Pisces about to turn 31. Your time of birth gives you Sagittarius on the Ascendant with the Moon, Mars, Saturn and Uranus in Sagittarius in this house as well as early Neptune in Capricorn. That is a lot of planetary real estate for one house to hold. The Moon in Sagittarius makes you a double Sagittarius and Mars and Uranus

close by make you very active, fiery, passionate and spontaneous in contrast to your Pisces Sun's more reserved tendencies. This planetary lineup is uniquely your own.
