GEMINI and THE YEAR AHEAD: Happy Birthday, Gemini! Your Sun Sign rules the chest cavity, hands, arms and shoulders in the communication-oriented 3rd House of brothers, sisters, cousins and other relatives as well as neighbors, classes and workshops, communities, education, transportation (all forms including purchasing and repairing of vehicles), media interests and networks, (phones, computers, faxes, Internet, social networks), writing and the diverse facets of your mind, especially how it works and the impact on your mental state. The 3rd house of the chart, regardless of Sun sign, describes your intellect and how you converse with others or form creative relationships; its natural ruler is Mercury. Jupiter has been particularly busy around those born June 4 and 14 and relates to important documents for your signature. Romance is in the wind for unattached Geminis. Be sure to pick up a lottery ticket or two in June. **When Jupiter moves to Scorpio in October it settles in for a year of highlighting your 6th House** of every day routines, health, nutrition, organization, fitness and pets. Pluto is at home in the 8th house, its natural habitat so the lessons are strong ones often involving deep internal attitude change. Many of you will examine the role that others' play in your life regarding finances, shared responsibility, money matters and intimacy. Do all the players carry a fair share of the load be it physical or financial? While Pluto clashes with Uranus in Aries in your solar 11th House of friendships and associates, you gain insight into what drains you emotionally and financially. The first two eclipses that affect you in 2017 have already occurred. The first fell on February 10, a lunar eclipse in Leo that occurred in your solar 3rd House of communication, education, neighborhood and community, cousins and siblings, mental attitude and transportation in all forms. Many Geminis get creative for the next year plus with eclipses in the zone; others find romance and have no trouble attracting a mate; still others spend much more time with babies and children either because you have a new addition to the family or you teach or coach younger

children; maybe you baby sit a lot more than usual. Mental stimulation gets your brain moving creatively. **The second eclipse was solar in Pisces and occurred in your 10th House of career and status on February 26th and plays out through August 21. This Moon's theme suggests that you grab the attention of the people in charge at your work place and subsequently undergo new, rewarding experiences related to your job, career, ambition or status in life.** What a great time to land the perfect job, move to a new location, retire or make cherished plans for your future that affect you and the family. Enjoy the attention from individuals who value your talent. Conversely, if other planets are involved and you are dissatisfied with the work scene, now is the time to seek a new assignment and go job hunting. You owe it to yourself to find the perfect fit. You have no reason to stay in an unfulfilling work environment, especially if you feel you have maxed out options to move ahead. Search for opportunities in your chosen field over the next few months and seek advice as you implement desired goals. **The third eclipse of the year is a full moon eclipse that falls on August 7 in Aquarius and influences your solar 9th House of long distance travel, higher education, spiritual matters, in-laws, medical and legal professionals and the publishing industry through February 15, 2018.** Sudden events are a hallmark of an eclipse in this sign and you may find yourself dwelling on an "ah ha" moment with sudden inspiration about what would truly perfect your life purpose starting with your current career. For some that means back to school to earn additional credentials or some on-the-job training in a related field. Health matters for you or another close family member bring medical specialists into your sphere. Acquisition of property calls for a legal opinion for some Geminis. Studying a new language fills a long-held desire for others. Be on the lookout for some fascinating speakers at upcoming events and turn on the charm. **When the next solar eclipse hits on August 21 (and it is a very powerful one that affects the U.S. chart and that of the President), it activates your solar 3rd House of local travel, early education, coursework, close relatives, communication and community events as well as vehicles and electronic devices. This eclipse lasts until January 31 when another Leo eclipse takes up the banner and deals with any unfinished business from this cycle for another 6 months to a year.** An eclipse in this position inspires you to clean up the environment in your office space, outdoors, your neighborhood and mental state. Whatever you started back in February deserves your final touch and a look at new developments that make a difference in how your goals and plans play out. If you are a writer, hop to it because the blast from the eclipse can be very inspirational and ideas flow. Share your creations and bask in the publicity. May 20-JUNE 20 PLANET ACTIVITY

Looking Skyward: As we start the Gemini cycle, **Mercury is in early degrees of Taurus**, dashes quickly through the sign of security before moving into versatile Gemini on June 7 and quickly finishing the sign by June 21. This directness represents a good time for advertisers, message delivery and a focus on the written word. Individuals and heads of state, CEOs and those in a position of prominence should remember that words carry a lot of weight and must choose them carefully whether orally or in writing - you just can't take them back. I thank the many readers and contacts who shared Mercury retrograde examples about the cycle that played out from April 9 to May 3. **Venus wraps up its cycle in Aries** on June 6th, and moves through deliberate Taurus through the end of the month, giving the dating crowd an opportunity to assess the strength of emerging relationships. This transit gives self-esteem a boost. Let love blossom and cherish your active social life. **Mars is on the Sun of many Geminis adding passion and energy to your aura through June 5 when it moves into family-oriented Cancer and gives you a reason to plan your summer outings.** Poll the family and then make a decision that brings fun and adventure to the mix. Transiting outer planet **Jupiter is retrograde and plays out in Libra until it goes direct on June 9th.** Now Jupiter covers 14-13 degrees of the sign and most affects those of you born October 5-8; Jupiter favorably aspects Aquarius born February 2-5, and Gemini born June 3-7; challenges occur for Aries born April 3-6, Cancer born July 4-8 and Capricorn born January 3-6. Jupiter favors purchasing big ticket items, homes, jewelry, furnishings or vehicles. Check with your astrologer before signing important papers or dealing with legal matters. Look for shifts in health matters, strengthen hips and joints or discuss options before scheduling surgery. **Saturn in Sagittarius is retrograde and most affects those born December 18-14,** Pisces born March 15-12, Gemini born June 17-13 and Virgo born September 19-15. The signs benefitting from a trine from Saturn are Aries, Leo and Sagittarius on dates listed above. A Saturn-Uranus trine plays out for a few more months and fuels goals and passions. Saturn also relates to karma so this aspect can help to bring balance and justice to those who have been treated unfairly in the past. Mars is in hard aspect to Saturn on May 29 so watch large-scale restrictions related to speech, transportation, document release and lack of funds for declared projects. Restructuring organizations is a prominent theme. **Uranus in Aries travels at 26-27 degrees** in diminishing hard aspect to Pluto in Capricorn and a trine to transiting Saturn in Sagittarius; those born under the signs Aries, Cancer, Libra and Capricorn or with planets at 26 through 27 degrees of these signs could experience unanticipated events out of the blue or find major life changes emerging in the next several weeks. Uranus in Aries benefits Aries born April 15-18, Leo born August 17-21 and Sagittarius born December 17-20. The transit plays out through December 19 when Saturn leaves Sagittarius. Be flexible in seeking solutions to evolving dilemmas. Uranus transits are main players in weather patterns, especially thunder and lightning strikes, earthquakes, tornados, fires (occurring in Florida as I write this section), train crashes and threatening war games (North Korea and Syria) that affect the lives of citizens in the US and abroad. **Neptune in Pisces goes retrograde on June 16 and stays retrograde until November 22. The planet joins the Suns of Pisces born March 4-6.** Spiritual energy may be very high along with romantic vibes, yet the astute must be aware of deceptive energy especially around the 16th when it is wise to steer clear of the mental confusion that

comes with this planet's shift. (See next section where I describe the Moon Wobbles that occur midway through the first set of eclipses that occur in any given year following a Mercury retrograde. This pattern paves the way for the next set of eclipses which occur in August. **In the meantime, focus is way off for many who feel uncertain over how to identify their life purpose.** Stay away from cons, schemers, habitual liars and slick salespeople. Focus on planning relaxing getaways, writing or journaling, finding an entertaining movie or two and pursuing promising romantic relationships. **Pluto in retrograde motion during this cycle moves slowly in Capricorn on the Suns of members born at the 19th and 18th degrees of the sign, approximately January 10-7.** The transit describes transformation and regeneration so let go of that you're holding on to and make change an adventure. Confront the obstacle and then visualize how life could be if you didn't have the problem. Enjoy any down time by evaluating your appearance - what one thing would you like to change? Then do some research along with fun reading and mystery or romantic pieces. "Cancel" the self-talk that leads you to doubt yourself. Our planet can use some cheer - start with you and think positively. Prepare for a breakthrough in the next 30 days. **Aries, Cancer and Libra with planets at 19-18 degrees also feel the transit in a jolting or eye-opening way even though the planet takes a while to get moving and is normally slow and insidious.** If you're an earth sign, Capricorn, Taurus or Virgo you benefit from smooth sailing through a pending change or meet success with a long-held goal. Global vision looks intently at revelations that deal with disclosures related to political arrangements and interference, false information, shady financial deals and emerging warfare. You have often read my comments about the "Karma Cleaners" coming to town when a strong Pluto transit takes place. Get ready! **Chiron in Pisces** is direct at 28 degrees and most affects those born March 17-19. Now is the time to embrace healing and eliminate painful memories or emotional clutter that stems from the past. Let go and live life to the fullest!

Several readers have written to say it still feels like we are experiencing Mercury Retrograde. Here is why: **The Moon's Nodes are shifting as I write this section and we are experiencing what is known as a Moon Wobble (5/9-28).** I have talked about it in previous newsletters. The Sun in Taurus is squaring (hard aspect) the North Node (Leo) and South Node (Aquarius) that have shifted this month in advance of the upcoming August eclipses. Nodes are points of intersection between the Moon's orbit and the path of the Sun over the Earth. We are witnessing a "real time" example of the Moon Wobble that continues through May 28 and suggests instability and "hot points" around the globe - not the time to make major decisions - but do expect major headlines coming from The White House and government leaders as we have seen in the last several weeks. Leo is the sign of leadership and strongly relates to politics, the leaders of nations, businesses and government. An aspect playing out in the heavens right now is called The Kite and an example of what it looks like reflects the President's chart and the transits that affect his natal planets. The President's Ascendant is Leo with Mars conjunct. Eclipses are hitting his 1st and 12th Houses and his 7th (the public, open enemies, partnerships) and 6th Houses (health and everyday dealings of the Nation). The August eclipses will be critical to this presidency; I'll discuss details in future editions. The Commander-in-Chief was born with the Full Moon in Sagittarius opposite his Sun in Gemini and right now Saturn in Sagittarius is advancing to the opposition showing the heat is on as we move forward to summer. Themes related to this shift continue for another 1-1/2 years. While I was writing this

section I saw a report from Reuters that the President's approval rating has dropped to the lowest point since the inauguration. On June 14, the President turns 71.

On a personal level look at the house where the North Node in Leo falls in your chart - that will be the hub of activity and more so if you have planets present. This shift brings in positive dynamics while the opposite house where the South Node in Aquarius falls is likely to help you release that which you no longer need. The truth sets you free; seek advice if you need more options. Then get ready for summer fun, new adventure and family reunions.

Voters narrowed down the field to include Gemini **Normani Kordei** with her Aries partner **Val Chmerkovskiy**; Pisces **David Ross** with his Capricorn partner **Lindsay Arnold**; and Aries **Rashad Jennings** and his Capricorn partner **Emma Slater**. **Cardinal signs rule:** 2 Aries, 2 Capricorns and then David and Normani are Mutable signs, Pisces and Gemini. Congratulations to all who competed in Season 24. Stay tuned.

White House Musings: Each day the public hears more from our Chief Executive about how much he loved his old life as a business magnate and how difficult he finds his new job. Those tweets are far-reaching and frequent; if there is a lull in the action, you can be sure it won't last for long. The Administration's agenda seems to be at a standstill and a look at how Pluto in the heavens is affecting the U.S. chart suggests that neither a favorable tax bill nor an acceptable health coverage bill will be in place in the near future. Increased military build-up might be a possibility though based on the increasingly tense dealings with hostile nations. Maybe in the absence of both the President and Jared Kushner, his son-in-law, the work crew can build another closet in the West Wing to house the increasing number of hats Kushner is wearing to support the President.

Reader messages about the barrage of stories and developments affecting our government have dominated my mail. I would need two newsletters to cover these stories due to the confusing comings and goings and new people on the scene and those that are leaving, hiding in bushes or being fired. Reports suggest that still another White House insider has fallen under the scrutiny of the Russia Probe. It seems like every day is chaotic and filled with allegations, accusations, alternative facts, name calling, collusion with unfriendly nations, divulging highly classified information, cover-ups, threats, misplaced loyalty and "secret" taping. Then we hear contradictions to previous messages delivered months, days or minutes ago. I had another page of research planned for this section to address your concerns but decided

to table it while special groups form to examine the Myths and the Realities behind the emerging facts, tweets and the vitriolic speeches including some delivered at college graduations. Today, the President left on his first foreign trip since taking office to visit the Middle East including Saudi Arabia and Israel, and The Vatican. You can be sure of non-stop coverage. Here is birthday information on James Comey and Robert Mueller two figures who will be in the public view for months ahead. More in future newsletters.

James Comey is a Sagittarius born December 14 with Mars in Cancer directly on the U.S. Sun, a configuration that describes his patriotism and desire to protect our country from enemies of the state. Comey's Sun is exactly opposite the President's so it is no surprise that they do not see eye-to-eye.

Robert Mueller, named Special Counsel for the Russia Investigation is a Leo born August 7 which happens to be the date of the next lunar eclipse which indicates prominence. Mueller has 6 Leo placements, the Moon in Pisces, a stellium of Virgo planets and three Cancer placements which highlight his interest in protecting national interests. READERS' CORNER

Thank you for the many questions and comments you sent during the past month. Although nothing compares to the abundance of questions I received regarding the President and the non-stop release of troubling news from The White House that hit the airwaves this month, I am addressing reader concerns in this space. Your responsiveness to the section on health matters kept me busy; several readers asked for more material on this topic. Six readers expressed interest in learning more about the Ascendant (another source of health information) and I am providing an overview of the Ascendant or Rising sign in response.

ASCENDANT

The Ascendant or Rising Sign is that sign, by degree and minute, that occupies the cusp (door) of your chart's First House. That First House cusp is calculated based on your exact time of birth. The Ascendant is one of the most complex places in the chart. It can be the aura a person projects when he or she presents a face to the world - business or social circles - yet it may conceal much of the person's true character that only intimates get to see. Often even those close to the individual may not get the true picture. Here are some general facts about the Ascendant. It is:

- ◆ A symbol of how one acts in the world.
- ◆ The "Mask" or "Image" of the personality that others see. Superficial part for some or "the real deal."
- ◆ Spontaneous energy and attitude toward life that penetrate the entire being.
- ◆ Either a "quite obvious" description of a person or the most elusive part of their birth chart.
- ◆ A part of you that you AUTOMATICALLY project.
- ◆ Essential part of person - deeply inner and outer part.

- ◆ The Gateway through which you confront the outer world—your individual approach to life.
- ◆ Something unique and essential about your personality.
- ◆ In attunement when major components of the chart support and harmonize with it.
- ◆ A partial portrayal of essential elements of your health.

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE ASCENDANT GENERAL

FIRE SIGNS RISING (Aries, Leo, Sagittarius): Great vitality, physical energy, beams energy out to the world; marked by positive, optimistic outlook on life and a confident, bluntly honest demeanor. Active; wants to make mark in life and see the results of efforts manifested in the world; action-orientation can lead to wasteful excesses and less awareness of the subtler needs of self and others.

AIR SIGNS RISING (Gemini, Libra, Aquarius): Mentally quick and active; inquisitive, social, friendly, verbal. Clever with rapid perceptions; can be overly intellectual to the point of chronically debating everything inwardly without acting. Wants to understand everything; at home in the world of concepts; natural facility for communication and perceiving others' viewpoints.

EARTH SIGNS RISING (Taurus, Virgo, Capricorn): A matter-of-fact outlook; focus on the material world and conservative attitudes can inhibit imagination (which may limit the person's options and/or restrain spontaneous self-expression. Steadiness and reliability are often well-developed and highly valued by self and others; practicality and inborn patience give more tolerance for routine than other Ascendants. A systematic approach is common way of expression.

WATER SIGNS RISING (Cancer, Scorpio, Pisces): Most easily influenced by the environment and by others; sensitive, moody, wary because of a strong feeling of vulnerability and likelihood of being hurt. Protective of self and others one cares about; sympathetic; feels others' emotions immediately and forcefully; very private; lives deeply within self.

CONFIDENTIAL TO ELUSIVE IN LOVE: Timing is everything. The alignment of planets in your natal chart to aspects from transiting planets create the opportunities to meet partners. If you don't have the aspects, the timing is off and no one suitable emerges.
