BIRTHDAY HIGHLIGHTS FOR AQUARIUS

Details follow on page 4. **Mars starts out in Aries, the sign of its ruler and moves to Taurus on February 14.** Be prepared for lively exchanges, cleaning up a backlog of tasks and scheduling important appointments. Check dates for surgery or important medical tests carefully. **Your solar 11th House is the setting for transiting Jupiter in Sagittarius which represents affiliations, friendships, groups, and organizations that interest you. Jupiter remains in Sagittarius until December 3rd when it moves**

into Capricorn for the remainder of your birthday year. Jupiter in the 11th House often brings funds from your company executives, promotions, career advancement, recognition, rewards, new employment opportunities, a leadership role, intense interaction with humanitarian enterprises, focus on goals, hopes and dreams and sorting out options for career reinvention. Blend idealism with practical insight to stabilize your life. **Pluto has been hanging around your solar 12th house in Capricorn since 2008. This house represents self-healing, widows, orphans, hidden enemies, introspection, quiet reflection, seclusion, private thoughts, behind-the-scenes-activity, secret trysts, visiting the sick, self-assessment and a pack rat mentality that may be addressed in 2019. The transit for the year ahead most affects those of you born February 9-13 and those of you with planets or Ascendants in Aries, Cancer and Libra through the remainder of your 2019 birthday cycle.** Simmering secrets surface and you no longer have to keep it all to yourself or avoid making the changes that bring more stability to your life. Aquarius is one of the fixed signs that has been bombarded with eclipses during 2017 through early 2019 along with your opposite sign Leo. This eclipse stays prominent through mid-2019 and concludes the**

Leo-Aquarius series that has kept you on your toes for the last few years. Keep an open heart to all you hear about relationships and prepare yourself to attract more loving and caring bonds in the future. If you only thought you prepared for the future and dealt with difficult scenarios, take a hard look and open your eyes and mind to changing scenarios. The truth sets you free. Examine individuals connected with your 7th House of business and personal partners. Clear communication and planning lead to insightful problem solving. Ride out the stress by using strategic coping mechanisms. Some Aquarians decide to elope if marriage is in the wind; otherwise, you attend more than your share of weddings and parties. **On July 2 you experience the second Solar Eclipse of 2019 at 11 degrees of Cancer in your solar 6th House of nutrition, the daily environment, health, routines, pets, organization, co-workers, attitude toward employment and how you address responsibility.** Work and career experiences of the past year brought security matters to light, altering your outlook and personal as well as professional relationships. Now you are ready to take the next steps. Update your appearance and wardrobe. Tune in to how you feel physically and what impression you want to make on bosses or those in a hiring capacity. Give an edge to the competition. If you are willing to move, what locations appeal to you and will most benefit your career choice? Use talent wisely. Use training effectively and demonstrate a willingness to pursue new skills. Stay positive. **The second lunar eclipse of your 2019 birthday occurs 2 weeks later with the cycle that begins with the July 16 eclipse in Capricorn in your in your solar 12th House of healing, retreat, planning, intuition, meditation, mediation, hospital or patient visiting, recovery after illness or emotional setbacks, developing new perspectives and secrets. This is a powerful one for you if you have planets near or in aspect to 24 degrees of Capricorn.** Security, family or health need attention and could have relevance to plans and goals. Make decisions about individuals who are key players in plans that are unfolding in your life. Be mindful that with Saturn and Pluto visiting this house simultaneously, they challenge plans, statements, blocks and anything that has been overlooked yet plays an important role in your future. It is important that you embrace your choices and go with the flow as you implement new plans. Manage issues as they come up and make adjustments along the way. **The last solar eclipse of 2019 falls December 26th in Capricorn at 4 degrees in your 12th house of solitude, behind-the-scenes activity, secret meetings or trysts, healing the mind, body and spirit, ending or beginning sabbaticals and planning fruitful discussions. Don't be surprised if what you experienced earlier this year in the 12th House reminds you of any loose ends that call for attention.** If you made changes last year that seemed drastic to observers, get ready to complete the transition that begs for relief. PLANETS PLACES FROM JANUARY 19-FEBRUARY 18

The Chinese Year of the Pig begins on February 5, 2019 and ends on January 24, 2020. The energy of this lunar new year is Yin Earth and commonly affiliates with emotions and intuition. The Pig is the last animal in the Chinese Zodiac. Those born this year are communicative, popular with friends and have a strong sense of timing. Be sure to pay attention to your health and reflect on matters pertaining to the health of others especially those under your care. Lucky numbers are 2, 5, 6 and 8. Pigs are most compatible with Rabbits, Tigers and Goats. The lucky colors are yellow, gray, brown and gold; Pig energy affiliates with the 10th Month; lucky flowers are hydrangea, daisy and lily. This year concentrate on career and life status; romance comes to certain Pigs based on astrological aspects.

Since Uranus went direct on January 6, no planet is retrograde during this cycle. **Two eclipses in January, the first, a solar eclipse on January 5th in Capricorn throw light on important facets of government, leadership and ambition and the second, at 0° & 52' Leo, is a Total Lunar Eclipse (Super Moon) and the last in the Leo-Aquarius cycle that takes place on January 21st when the spotlight is on children, creativity, love and romance.** Take note of the house where this eclipse occurs in your chart and whether it is on, near or in close aspect to one of your planets so you know how to direct matters connected with that house. For example, if the eclipse occurs on the cusp of your 1st House of self-expression, action, passion and innovation, you may have considerable plans to implement. If the eclipse is on the cusp of your 10th House of career and status, a new job, boss or organizational development may take place. Depending on the presence of planets in the house, the eclipse may involve your family status or parents. Those born with planets at 0° of Leo, Scorpio, Aquarius or Taurus are most affected. Plans in the works within two weeks prior to eclipses rarely work out as expected; what occurs afterward is much more important. **Mercury completes its passage through Capricorn on January 24th before moving into Aquarius on February 10th and remains in Aquarius through February 17 before moving to Pisces through the rest of February.** Expect news about the outcome of government business and rights of employees and displaced groups. **Mercury begins the Aquarian cycle in Capricorn, zips through Aquarius and on to**

Pisces where it travels in harmonious aspect to lovely Venus in Capricorn promoting overtures of romance on Valentine's Day. They seem to speak the language of love and savor the conversation. **Mars wraps up a stint in fiery Aries then ambles to Taurus to create a calm connection among these personal planets on February 14th.** The action planet loves the chase but learns a lesson in practicing patience with Uranus moving toward reentry into Taurus in March. While planets are direct, take the time to review your goals or launch projects you have placed on hold. If your goals and plans need a boost, make revisions now. Demonstrate a competitive spirit in your workplace or in pursuing favorite people or hobbies. **Jupiter in Sagittarius forms a hard aspect to Neptune in Pisces as these two mutable planets display clashing attitudes regarding global and local religious or spiritual rights and perspectives.** The vibe can push people to extremes where they forget reason and insist on their views. Those born December 5-10 and March 4-9 experience the most drama yet have considerable opportunity to expand perspectives as do individuals born June 4-9 and September 6-11. Individuals born February 2-7, May 4-9 and August 6-11 should carefully examine options and select dates for initiating new projects, marriage, surgery, travel and the scheduling of important meetings. **Saturn travels in Capricorn during this cycle and forms a harmonious aspect to transiting Neptune in Pisces. This month it most affects you if born January 3-7, April 2-6, July 4-8 or October 6-10. Those born March 3-7 benefit from the action.** If you have taken the time to look at effective ways to solve problems, Saturn aids you in revising and grounding issues. The emphasis is on social systems and structures with the emphasis on spiritual and religious outlooks with Neptune in the mix now. The task-master planet wants to use logic to find the truth in that which has been distorted or exploited. Insight aids in solving long-standing problems and verifying facts when examining information. Out with high drama and in with the truth. The flow of information is strong during February; so is the voice of the public. Watch what happens around February 7. **Uranus went direct on January 5 but still travels in late Aries while challenging those born with planets at 28-29 degrees of Capricorn, Aries, Cancer and Libra, those born the last two days of their signs. New energy emerges when the planet of the unexpected moves to Taurus on March 6, 2019 and spends the next 7 years in that sign, often hitting the same degree multiple times.** Meanwhile deal with truth, integrity and communication matters that have surfaced in your life during the past year. The world in general could use an alternative to displaying rigid behavior patterns. How about you? The challenge with transiting Jupiter in Sagittarius in hard aspect to Neptune, holds the release at bay. Lingering Uranus in late Aries demonstrates unfriendly vibes. Revelation is close. **Chiron is direct in Pisces during this cycle and most affects those born March 18-20**

who desire an awakening of the mind and conscious feeling as they inhale a deep healing vibe. Pisces can eliminate fear and replace it with self-confidence and release of lessons that challenged conditions in this lifetime. The Wounded Healer plays a role in helping you face the truth about people, places and conditions you have encountered. Process any lingering grief that has accelerated life-long concerns and you will know all the benefits of inner peace. If you were **born with Chiron in Pisces, this is your Chiron return** so check the house where it resides to focus on the best solution for releasing stuck energy and experience a return to better physical and mental health. **Pluto in Capricorn resides at the 21st and 22nd degrees this month** most affecting those born January 11-14 as well as other cardinal signs Aries (April 10-13), Cancer (July 13-16), and Libra (October 14-17). Wherever Pluto falls in your chart you have opportunities to release unwanted baggage; uncover the truth about people and events; complete karma; eliminate fears; cherish your inner strengths and regenerate life phases. PEOPLE, PLACES AND TOPICS IN THE NEWS

The main topics on readers' minds this month revolve around government activity including the shutdown, ordering employees to work with no pay, fear of economic downturn, safety of citizens, the building of the border wall at taxpayers' expense when no crisis exists, citing a victory over ISIS then calling for a pullout of troops in Syria which was followed by the murder of 4 American troops, and the horror over moves to reject NATO that responds to the agenda of Vladimir Putin. Additional concerns are allegations of rigging polls in the 2016 Election, lying over dealings with Russia and all the late and discouraging news that broke this week including denying use of a military plane for Nancy Pelosi's use in accordance with regulations established after 911 to protect those in direct line of succession for the Presidency (the Administration is sorely lacking in knowledge of rules yet subsequently OK'd use of the same plane to take Melania to Mara-Lago for a vacation.) Others asked about the overturn of Brexit and how this rejection of a hard line might impact activity in the US. Some readers wrote about their personal hardships regarding absence of funds to pay bills, mortgages and buying groceries as well as loss of business due to the shutdown; others showed concern for the U.S. as a nation. These are the main questions I get as well as those from readers who want to know what is going on in our leader's chart. Yes, this activity is reflected strongly so watch the vibes from January 21st (date of the Super Moon eclipse) through February 15. Then, a number of revelations evolve over the next 6 months. Stay tuned!

The Acting Awards' season is underway through the February 24th broadcast of the Oscar ceremonies; the announcement of nominations occurs on January 22. The early awards broadcasts often set the tone for what is to come at the season finale. The

READERS CORNER

Several readers wrote in expressing an interest in changing jobs and mentioned frustration in the job interview process. They asked for tips on how to plan for an interview, ask and answer questions during the interview and how active they should be to experience success in obtaining a new position. If this material fits your current situation, I hope you, too, find this tips helpful.

Q. I am an Aquarius and have been seeking a new position for almost a year. I have no trouble landing interviews, yet something seems to go wrong each time and I seldom get a call back for a second interview. My last interview was on January 11. How compatible was this date for seeking a new job? I have heard nothing to date. What can I do to better prepare for the interview process? Thank you for your insight.

A. You are an Aquarius born with Mercury in Sagittarius. On the day of your interview the Moon was in Pisces in hard aspect to natal Mercury while Jupiter in Sagittarius (area you wish to expand) was in a tense aspect to transiting Neptune in Pisces. Something you said or an element of communication may have been unclear, confusing or lacked organization. Did you follow through? It is still early to rule out a callback since only a little over a week has passed since your interview. A day with planets more compatible with yours would have been a better fit. That is something to

consider when planning future opportunities; check with your astrologer before committing to a date.

After finding the perfect job that whets your appetite to work in the new environment, your first step is to make a good impression. Update your resume to tailor it to the specific needs of the company. To snag an interview, it is a good idea to send a well thought out cover letter along with your resume to a specific contact person (hiring authority) from the firm. You will have to do your homework to identify key individuals and particular points listed in the job announcement that highlight your qualifications. Recruiters like to see how well you personalize your assets to what they need. Be sure you thank the recruiter in advance for his or her time and ask to meet to discuss your qualifications. Limit words and use a positive tone in seeking the interview so your letter reflects professionalism. Use active voice. Be sure to proofread your work (many candidates don't) and include all contact information you wish to share. Strong communication skills are often a prerequisite for the job, so put your best foot forward now.

After you have landed the interview be sure you are fully prepared for a successful outcome. Make a checklist that starts with getting a good night's sleep, eating breakfast or lunch depending on the interview time, getting your interview clothing ready the night before and packing your briefcase with essential items you may need during the interview that may include: two pens, a notebook, extra copies of your resume, a stain remover sheet or pen, breath mints but never gum, deodorant, touch-up make-up in case you need it, and an information cheat sheet that includes information and contact numbers for the interviewer, the company, the job that interests you and any questions you have based on what you have learned. Be sure you have mapped out the route to the interview location and know where you will park. Once the interview is over be sure to send a thank you note to the interviewer and anyone else who may have participated in the meeting such as the leader or another official. I wish you the best in future endeavors and look forward to working with you to help you plan advantageous times to schedule appointments.
