This eclipse plays out through May 5. Those of you who travel for business are hitting the airwaves and the highways again. **Last year's final lunar eclipse took place on November 8 in Taurus at 16° ♉ 01'** in your solar third house of communication, education, local travel, neighbors, cousins, siblings, and transportation. PLANETS' POSITIONS FEBRUARY 18 - MARCH 20

The big news this month is that Saturn is moving to your sign, Pisces, on March 7 where it will be firmly planted for the almost three years in the house in your chart ruled by Pisces (Neptune). Get ready to assess major facets of your life, especially your Sun sign. **Mercury starts out the month in intellectual Aquarius during this period and then moves into Pisces on March 2 at 5:52 PM EDT** where it completes its cycle on March 19 before moving to Aries just after midnight. Saturn in Aquarius leaves the sign on March 7 affecting those born February 16-19 this month as it exits after 2-1/2 years. Playboy ranked her at Number Three as one of the 100 sexiest stars of the Twentieth Century. Raquel starred in *One Million Years B.C.* in 1966 wearing a two-piece deer skin bikini which brought her instant fame as a pin-up girl. She won a Golden Globe Award for Best Actress in a Musical or Comedy in 1974 for her performance in *The Three Musketeers*. She made numerous movies from 1964-2017 and guested on various television shows from 1964-2017. She had two children. Raquel died on February 15, 2023, at her home in Los Angeles following a brief illness.

Burt Bacharach: A Taurus born May 12, in Kansas City, Missouri, was an American composer, songwriter, record producer, and pianist who has had a significant influence on 20th century popular music. He composed hundreds of pop songs from the late 1950s collaborating with lyricist Hal David. His name was a household word for decades, and he was featured in numerous films and television shows, variety specials, and musicals. It's no surprise that his chart shows planets in Taurus that favor a musical career. Venus in Taurus is conjunct Chiron in Taurus for one, an indicator that music was not only a passion but a healing balm for this music legend. Mercury in Gemini in harmony with Uranus in Aries shows that spontaneity could lead to a stream of prolific activity in musical composition. He wrote for the biggest and the best in his heyday. Burt died on February 8 in Los Angeles. May he rest in peace.

READERS CORNER

I received numerous messages from readers responding to last month's question related to Valentine's Day and gift giving. Thank you for sharing your personal experiences in this matter. They are positive and upbeat. Most agree that a small, special gift is most appropriate. This month I'm focusing on questions that are significant across the board about transiting planets. I hope yours is answered here.

Q Readers often get impatient when an outer planet remains in a house for years and the key issues continue to be relevant. Sometimes they ask me why my

advice is similar in more than one year. Hey, it is your chart that holds the key to the timing for releasing these planets. For example, Pluto has been in Capricorn since 2008 and Neptune has been in Pisces since 2011; Uranus in Taurus since 2018. These planets take the longest to move through the sign they are transiting and can stay in a house for a long time. Outer planet Saturn takes approximately 2-1/2 years to move through a sign and will be significant if you have more than one planet at a different degree ranging from 0 to 30 degrees. Jupiter has a one-year cycle, so you meet it in a different sign in a different house in your chart each year and meet each sign for a repeat performance every twelve years. That means that every year a sign will visit a department (house) in your chart, and aspects to natal planets will influence the relevance to your chart. Ask your astrologer for help in understanding it.

A. It just takes patience to sit through a long passage of a planet in the same house for several years. That transit is more complicated if you have actual natal planets in that house as each of them will experience the intense conjunction on a natal planet at some time during the long transit. The conjunction may have diverse effects on your chart's pattern depending on whether other planets become a part of the intensity. If you read this column each month you know that many readers have complaints about Pluto in Capricorn and the places where they feel stuck. That long cycle is coming to a close in 2024, and in 2023, Pluto moves to Aquarius briefly to give you a glimpse of how the planet may affect you during its long cycle. Its official passage will be from November 19, 2024, until March 9, 2043. The most important lesson for you to understand concerns what changes you have noticed in issues where you feel stuck. If planets occupy that house, you will notice a difference in the form of release the transit takes.

During the last few months, I have heard from others curious about how Saturn in Pisces will affect them. Many, but not all, querents are Pisces. This taskmaster planet will move out of Aquarius and into Pisces on March 7. A full moon in Virgo occurs on that day, too! As a water sign, Pisces is not going to dominate Saturn the way Capricorn and Aquarius have even while they have hit a brick wall and have been unable to move government into better action to improve the fate of the people and the governing conditions for the people. Contention and opposition simply won't cut it. Congress is at a stalemate with reactionary behavior dominating. Meanwhile Saturn in Pisces arrives on the scene amidst structural breakdowns where everything feels worn out and needs a makeover. Saturn is a newbie in Pisces now and has to get on the right path to be effective and build momentum. That will happen after a full assault of storms, global accidents, breakdowns, severe weather patterns, political fiascos, balloons, and exhaustion from trying to find the money to fund repairs and help other countries. On an individual basis, keep your eye on the house in your natal chart where you will experience this nearly three-year Saturn cycle. Remember that Pisces is the sign of the healer and moves toward the inspiration of Neptune to uphold spiritual ideals in lieu of retaliation and holding on to anger, which never solve problems. The old ways are not working. Join together as a family and a nation to find balance and listen carefully to new and appealing ideas that will have merit in due time.
